He has been invited as artist in residence to the Vermont Studio Center in 2002, Glasgow Print Studio in 2004 and Museograbado Zacatecas in 2006. He was recipient of the National Fund for Arts and Culture Young Artists Fellowship two times, in 2002 and 2006. In 2007 he was awarded with the first prize of the National Biennial of Art in Yucatan, Mexico.
